Section 16.04.340 of Ordinance No. 453, of the Menlo Park Zoning Ordinance, defines a proper home occupation as follows: "Home Occupation" is any activity conducted on the premises by the occupant of the dwelling as a secondary use in connection herewith, and where there are no advertising signs, no display, no stock or commodity stored or sold on the premises, no employees in connection therewith and no mechanical equipment to be used in connection therein, other than that necessary or convenient for domestic purposes. Said activity shall not be conducted in an accessory building.

Application Fee is \$93 (nonrefundable). Please submit payment with application. This permit is issued one time only. Please notify our office of change of address.
