The City of Menlo Park will be gathering for the inaugural Black Liberation Celebration at Belle Haven Branch Library Saturday, Feb. 11, 2023, from Noon–3 p.m. This celebration will include a Black History Month Youth Poster Exhibition. We invite all elementary, middle and high school students who live in or attend school in Menlo Park to submit a poster to be included in the Black History Month Youth Poster Exhibition.

The exhibition will start Saturday, Feb. 11, 2023, at the Belle Haven Branch Library and run through, Sunday, Feb. 19, 2023. It will then be moved to the Menlo Park Library starting Tuesday, Feb. 21, 2023, and run through Tuesday, Feb. 28, 2023. All Submissions are due by Sunday, Feb. 5, 2023.

All posters and submission forms must be delivered to the help desk at the Belle Haven Branch Library, 413 Ivy Drive or the Menlo Park Library, 800 Alma St. before 4 p.m., Sunday, Feb. 5, 2023.

You can pick up your posters from the same library that you submitted the poster to starting Tuesday, March 7–Tuesday, March 21. No posters will be available after this date.

Guidelines

1. The Black History Month Youth Poster Exhibition Submission is open to all elementary, middle and high school students, both public and private schools, who live in or attend school in Menlo Park.
2. The subject of the poster can be what inspires the student related to Black History.
3. Posters should be any size between the minimum dimensions of 8.5"x11" to a maximum dimension of 12"x18".
4. Posters may be created in any 2-dimensional medium (oil, acrylic, markers, pastel, collages, photography, canvas mounted on poster board and others). Posters may be created or enhanced digitally but must begin as an entirely original work of art by the student and printed to the required size for submission.
5. All submitters are allowed to use their own poster board and art supplies.
6. Poster boards and submission forms will also be available at the help desk at both the Menlo Park Library and the Belle Haven Branch Library locations during business hours starting Tuesday, Jan. 10–Sunday, Feb. 5. Art supplies can also be borrowed from the help desk during these dates, but must remain at these library locations and will be available on a first come first serve basis.
7. Each student is limited to 1 poster submission. Each poster will need to be submitted with this submission form or can be picked up from the help desk at both the Menlo Park Library and the Belle Haven Branch Library.
8. Please note that there is a possibility that not all poster submissions will be displayed at the exhibition due to limited space, however best efforts will be made to display as many poster submissions as possible.

Prizes for participating

All students who submit a poster and a submission form by the submission deadline will be entered into a raffle. \$100 gift cards will be drawn on Feb. 11, 2023, for three different winners. Raffle winners will be randomly selected. This exhibition is not a contest.

Ownership of artwork

Ownership of the artwork submitted will remain with the artist. The City of Menlo Park reserves the right to publish any and all artwork submitted for this exhibit digitally, along with the artist's first name and school. The City of Menlo Park will affix items on the back of the poster for display purposes.
