


Overdrive eBooks on Windows or Mac computers & laptops and non-Kindle, black & white e-readers (Nook, Sony, etc.)

Ebooks require Adobe Digital Editions
Go to **Adobe.com**
Click the **search** icon
Enter **Digital Editions**
Click the **Download now** link



Choose the installer for your Mac or PC

Adobe Digital Editions 4.5.9 Installers

Locate your preferred platform and click on it to download the installer. Then run the installer on your machine to install Adobe Digital Editions.





Once downloaded, **run the installer**.

Go to <http://pls.overdrive.com> in a web browser on your computer, and click **Sign In**




Select your library from the list, and then enter your library card number




Click **Search** to reveal the simple search box.

Continue by clicking **Advanced** to create a search limited by format, genre, availability, etc.



Under **Formats**, choose **All ebooks**

Under **Availability**, you may want to choose **Available Now**




When you find a book you want, click **Borrow**


Change the borrowing period if you like, and click **Borrow**



Authorize Your Computer

Authorizing your computer enables you to:

- Easily transfer Adobe DRM protected items between multiple computers and mobile devices.
- Read Adobe DRM-protected items on computers or mobile devices (up to six).
- Restore your content from backup whenever you need to re-install the OS.





If you plan to access your ebook on other devices, you should create an Adobe ID so you can register each device with the same account. Then your ebooks will be synced on all the devices. To create an ID:

- Go to **Adobe.com**
- Click **Sign In**
- Click **Get an Adobe ID**
- Fill out the form and click **Sign Up**



After authorizing, ADE will open your book. It also appears on your Bookshelf, where you can right click it to return it early.




To transfer an ebook to your ereader, open the "Library" view in ADE (click the **Library** button in the top-left corner, if needed).

Connect your ereader to your computer with a cable. The ereader should then appear on the left under "Devices". You may need to accept a file-transfer prompt on your ereader in order for it to appear in ADE.

Drag and drop the ebook into your ereader.

Once you've transferred a library ebook, you can read it on your device just like any other ebook.

Note: During the transfer process, your ereader will be automatically authorized with the same Adobe ID or OverDrive account you used on your computer.
