## C. REGULAR BUSINESS

1. City Council Priorities, Goals and Budget.

Mr. David Boesch and Ms. Audrey Seymour, City Manager and Assistant City Manager respectively, presented information to Council on General Fund challenges, Mission and Goals and the upcoming budget process. The Council discussed their views on cost recovery for certain services, investing more in infrastructure, and wanting staff's recommendations on citywide reductions. In regards to possible voluntary terminations Council emphasized the need to begin negotiations with the Unions early on.

Council consensus was to begin working on a mission statement that includes feedback from the advisory bodies. This mission should also bear some relation to the General Plan. Council expressed a desire to improve communication with Commissions specifically on follow-up for projects and recommendations that these bodies made.
