D. CONSENT CALENDAR

- Rescind Resolution number 5929, which increased water rates for the Menlo Park Municipal Water District over a five-year period, and replace it with a corrected resolution which includes a pass-through provision if San Francisco Public Utilities Commission increases for wholesale water (including water management charges) exceed \$3.21 per billing unit prior to July 1, 2014 (<u>Staff report # 10-157</u>)
