SaveFloodPark (a community group) has organized a community meeting regarding the following and has invited the City Council to attend.

<u>Purpose for the meeting</u>: Flood Park is currently closed. County Supervisors will vote in late June on a recent staff recommendation to keep Flood Park closed indefinitely as part of the County's budget cutting measures.

However, the County is currently in talks with the City of Menlo Park regarding the possible transfer of the park to the city. The purpose of the community meeting is to show city officials that Flood Park's neighbors are ready to cooperate and assist them in creating a plan to reopen the park when the water pipeline project is completed in September.

The public is invited to attend this community meeting.
