

Rail Subcommittee Meeting on the Caltrain Electrification Draft EIR

Thursday, April 24, 2014 at 6:00pm Administration Building City Council Conference Room 701 Laurel Street, Menlo Park

Caltrain released a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for its Peninsula Corridor Electrification Project (PCEP) on February 28, 2014. Menlo Park's City Council Rail Subcommittee is hosting a community workshop to discuss the City's comments on the DEIR.

The PCEP would electrify the Caltrain Corridor from San Francisco to San Jose, convert diesel to electric trains, and increase Caltrain service by 2019. While this project does not include or study all infrastructure necessary to implement high-speed rail service on the corridor (such as HSR maintenance facilities, station improvements, or passing tracks), the electrical infrastructure (such as overhead wire systems) will be compatible with later blended service.
