A. PUBLIC COMMENT

Jim Lewis commented on the Great Spirit Path Sculptures restoration project at Bedwell Bayfront Park, which has a tentative completion date of spring 2015 *(Handout)*

B1. Consider a Recommendation on a Request to Remove One Valley Oak Heritage Tree at 1025 San Mateo Drive (*Attachment*)

Public Comment

Hossein Jalali, owner of the property where the Valley Oak tree is located, briefed the Commission on the condition of the tree and his support for the removal. Since the tree poses a hazard and may break at any time, Mr. Jalali does not want to be liable for damage.

Commissioner Bedwell arrives at 7:00pm

- Sally Cole, appellant and property owner of 1235 Santa Cruz, stated that her backyard faces the Valley Oak and based on her informal assessment of the tree she concluded that the tree is free from structural defects and should not be removed.
- Betsy Nash, neighbor of Sally Cole, advocated for leaving in as many trees as possible. Ms. Nash stated that the Valley Oak is aesthetically pleasing and if the Oak does need to be removed than it should be replaced with an appropriate tree.

ACTION: Motion and Second (DeCardy/Martin) to deny the appeal based on the Heritage Tree criteria as stated in the arborist report, passes (5-1-1), (Absent: Kuntz-Duriseti, Noes: Bedwell).
