DEPARTMENT STATISTICS -SEPT. 2023 TO SEPT. 2024 COMPARISON



- Belle Haven Library circulation and foot traffic
 - Circulation more than doubled from 918 to 2,142 items
 - Foot traffic nearly tripled from 1,169 to 3,117
- Gymnastics enrollment
 - Steady increase from 590 enrolled in 80 classes to 862 enrolled in 114 classes
- Drop in volleyball at Arrillaga Family Gymnasium
 - Significant increase 513 visits to 930 visits
- Older adults/senior class enrollment
 - Decrease in enrollment from 701 in 14 classes to 220 in 16 classes, a decrease of 68%.

BURGESS PARK TENNIS COURT RESURFACING PROJECT

- Project near completion
 - Update completed on Oct 17
- Two courts available
 - One available for drop-in
 - Second is available for reservation(at a fee) and drop-in when not reserved

- Pilot program, free to participants
- Available to match players of similar skill level
- All skill levels welcome to join beginners to advance
- Registration form available online



KELLY PARK TURF AND TRACK REPLACEMENT PROJECT



- Last renovated in 2010, end of serviceable life span
- Project scope:
 - Remove and replace rubberized track
 - Replace and replace exercise stations; add shade structures
 - Remove and replace synthetic turf
 - More environmentally sustainable coconut fiber-based underlayment
 - Striping, marking, and irrigation laterals
 - Funded in 5 year capital improvement program
- Timeline (tentative)
 - Construction start Spring 2025; after installation of solar carports
 - Project completion in Summer 2025



FLYWAY TRAIL OPENING CELEBRATION

- Wetlands restoration project, Don Edwards Nation Wildlife Refuge
 New trail
- City co-hosted opening celebration
 - Bedwell Bayfront Park Saturday, Oct 19th
 - Guided nature walks, games, hands-on demonstrations, educational booths
