



Background

Spring 2022:

Coleman and Ringwood Avenues Transportation Study project kick off

Nov. 19, 2024:

City Council accepted the Coleman and Ringwood Avenues Transportation Study









Oct. 22, 2024:

City Council direction to proceed with improvements in City's portion through a pilot

March 12:

Complete Streets Commission feedback



City Council Direction

Project elements:

- A bike lane westbound (toward Ringwood Avenue)
- A shared lane with people biking and people driving eastbound (toward Willow Road)
- No parking on the north side of Coleman Avenue to allow sufficient roadway space for bike lane
- A stop sign on Coleman Avenue at Santa Monica Avenue
- Traffic calming measures (rubberized speed cushions) to reduce speeds of people driving




Figure: Pilot option 5B from the Coleman and Ringwood Avenues Transportation Study




Overnight Parking
