This is a special door-to-door service for those who are not near a shuttle or need a little extra assistance, taking you directly from your house to your destination. Operates on Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays. No service on federal holidays or their observed days. Exceptions: service on Veterans Day.

How does it work?

The shuttle will begin picking up passengers at 9:30 a.m. to take them to their destinations. Patrons have about 2 hours at the destination, then will be picked up to go back home starting at 12:30 p.m.

How to reserve a ride

This free service only runs Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays, from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. This service must be reserved at least one day in advance. To schedule a ride, please call:
