	Yerba Buena Type: groundcover	3.6' - 7' tall 3' - 12' wide	low	full sun, part shade
	California Lilac Type: shrub	2' - 6' tall 10' - 12' wide	low	full sun, part shade
	California Poppy Type: perennial	0.5' - 2' tall 1' - 3' wide	very low, low	full sun
	California Fescue Type: grass	1.3' - 4' tall 3' wide	very low	full sun, part shade
	California Sagebrush Type: shrub	1' - 6' tall 4' wide	extremely low, very low	full sun
	Golden Yarrow Type: perennial	1.6' - 2.3' tall 1.5' wide	very low	full sun
